

# JIM BRADLEY ADL LEGACY SCHOLARSHIP

## NOW ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS

### PURPOSE:

A scholarship provided to an Island grade 12 student that has plans to pursue a career related to the PEI agriculture industry.

The scholarship is in honour of former ADL CEO Jim Bradley in recognition of his leadership in the PEI dairy industry over his 36-year career with ADL and 14 years as ADL CEO.

**AMOUNT:** \$1,000.00

### CRITERIA:

- The \$1,000.00 scholarship is available to any PEI high school student entering post-secondary education (college or university) to pursue a career related to the PEI agriculture industry.
- Applicants must complete the application and will need to provide: their current education/school, the name of the post-secondary program that they have been accepted to, updated school transcripts, and an outline of their future career goals and how they relate to the PEI agriculture industry and summarizing their leadership experience in the community.
- Applicants must also include two references, one of which must be a PEI agriculture industry stakeholder or industry representative.

### APPLICATION DEADLINE:

April 30, 2026.
